TUITION

*The Capital Development Fee paid in Pre-Kindergarten will be applied to the K-12 Capital Development Fee.

Please note the following:

1. All fees are established annually by the AISB Board of Directors.
2. Tuition includes the use of necessary textbooks.
3. The registration fee of \$350 must be paid with the enrollment application.
4. Tuition is due and payable on or before 24 September 2010. For students who register for school after August 24th, 2010, tuition is due and payable within 30 days after the date of registration. Upon written request in advance, the director may authorize a different payment schedule.
5. Students for whom tuition remains outstanding as of December 1st are subject to a penalty of 5%. These students may be excluded from classes and their school records will not be released.
6. Students who do not attend school the entire school year will have their tuition prorated by the academic quarter. Students who attend any portion of a quarter must pay for the entire quarter.
7. Students withdrawing must notify the Director in writing at least thirty (30) days in advance.
8. Payment shall be made in U.S. currency or with the Director's approval in Francs CFA. For Francs CFA, the current dollar rate (500f/\$) is set annually by the Board of Directors.
9. There is a surcharge for dollar checks not drawn on banks not in the U.S.
